FOREWORD

Following our customary practice, last summer we asked the Honorable W. M. Beall, president of the Bar Association of the State of Kansas, whose photograph is shown on the cover, to prepare an article on a subject of his own choosing for publication in this issue of the Bulletin. About the middle of August we received a letter from Mr. Beall enclosing an article which he had written, and in the letter he stated that he and his wife were leaving shortly thereafter to drive to the American Bar Association Convention in Miami Beach, Florida. Their trip was cut short, however, for in Texarkana, Arkansas, he was stricken with a perforated ulcer and hospitalized. He was confined to the hospital until his death on September 3rd. Funeral services and burial were in Clay Center on September 7th. We know that the article prepared by him will be of interest to our readers.

Mr. Beall was born near Grantville on May 27, 1891, and was graduated from the Perry High School and the law school of the University of Kansas. He was admitted to the practice of law in 1917 and located in Clay Center where he was continuously engaged in the general practice until his death. He served as county attorney of Clay County for two terms, and at the time of his death was serving as state senator from the 20th District (Clay and Dickinson Counties). During World War I he served in the United States Navy.

His wife was the former Ailene L. Carlson of Clay Center, and they had one daughter, Mary Elizabeth, now Mrs. George R. Jones of Wichita, both of whom survive.

Over the years Mr. Beall had been very active in civic affairs, having served on the Board of Trustees of the Clay Center Municipal Hospital; on the Board of Education of the City of Clay Center; on the Board of Trustees of St. John's Military School at Salina, and he was Chancellor of the Diocese of Kansas of the Episcopal Church for 15 years. He was a member of Rotary International (District Governor 1941-1942); American Legion; Masonic orders; Sigma Chi Fraternity; Phi Delta Phi, legal fraternity, and the Episcopal Church.

He also was a member of the Clay County Bar Association; Central Kansas Bar Association; Bar Association of the State of Kansas, and the American Bar Association. He represented the 5th District on the Executive Council of the Bar Association of the State of Kansas 1947-1957. In 1957 he was elected vice-president and in the following year president-elect.

This issue of the BULLETIN also contains summarized tables showing the volume of work in the supreme court, the district courts, probate courts, county courts and city courts of the state for the year ending June 30, 1959. The Judicial Council requests your study of the statistical information shown in the tables and invites suggestions as to any improvements that could be made in the form and content of the information collected.

Observations Respecting the Code of Legal Ethics

Every once in a while some lawyer complains "Why don't the law schools give a course in professional ethics?" This is usually prompted by the fact that some lawyer of his acquaintance has, in his judgment, deviated slightly from a course of conduct he considers to be good and proper. The criticism may, or may not, be justified. Just the same, however, the propriety of the lawyer's action under a certain set of circumstances has been questioned, and therein lies the importance of the subject of ethics.

The law schools do teach legal ethics. One of our law schools gives a required one-hour course for one semester, and the subject is more or less emphasized in other ways throughout the entire law school course. The other law school gives a course in ethics, but it is optional. As in the case of the other law school, the general subject is brought out in many ways during the course.

Legal ethics is one of the subjects upon which applicants for admission to the Bar may be examined. Rule VI of the rules adopted by the State Board of Law Examiners provides for it. But in spite of all this, the problem of the erring brother keeps coming up. I suppose it may safely be said the subject simply did not "take." To be sure, he was able to answer the questions and all that. What he failed to realize, apparently, was that the rules laid down in the canons are to be observed, and not ignored. They are entitled to more than lip service. They are to be lived by. These rules are the distilled essence of many long years of experience.

To brand a lawyer as unethical is a severe indictment. His reputation as a lawyer necessarily suffers. Prestige, once lost, is difficult to regain. In 1928, when Mr. Justice Cordoza was a member of the New York Court of Appeals, he observed:

"Reputation in such a calling (the law) is a plant of tender growth, and its bloom, once lost, is not easily restored." (People ex rel Karlin v. Culkin, 248 N. Y. 465, 479; 162 N. E. 487, 492; 60 A. L. R. 851, 859.)

Each of us, therefore, should keep in mind that the right to practice law is not a vested right. It is rather a license granted to us by the state to practice so long as we continue to merit it. It (the license) might be suspended, or even completely lost, through dishonest, unfaithful or unprofessional conduct. Implicit in every license are, or should be, not only sound learning, but more especially exemplary character and ethical principles.

Like Caesar's wife, the lawyer in his professional life should be above suspicion. A considerable by-product of the observance of this concept of our duties and responsibilities as lawyers, to mention one, would be the elimination of many public relations problems. The ethical lawyer is no problem.

Many articles have been written in recent years with respect to the economic status of lawyers. These were all to the good. They called attention to the fact that the profession generally had not kept pace with the trend of the times. As a result, I think lawyers generally have greatly improved their position. The possession, by even some country lawyers, of expensive automobiles, comfortable homes and the other external evidences of prosperity all attest to this fact. A recent survey made in Missouri indicates that the average lawyer in

that state earns about \$18,000.00 a year before taxes. I doubt whether Kansas lawyers do as well, but even so, I am confident most of them are prospering. This is as it should be. All will recall Sir Winston Churchill's famous statement that he was not chosen Prime Minister to preside over the liquidation of the British Empire. To paraphrase that thought, neither did we become lawyers to pauperize ourselves in the service of our clients. As in the case of the laborer, we are worthy of our hire.

But, as a profession, we should constantly bear in mind that ours is not a "mere money-making trade" (Canon 12). We cannot advertise. We cannot solicit. We cannot do many other things to attract clients. These restraints are the things that distinguish the profession from commercial enterprises. We must necessarily rely on ability and character to attract clients. There is no other substitute. A case well tried, or a difficult assignment well performed, is our best advertisement. We have no bargains to offer, nor excess stock to unload.

In rare instances we will find a lawyer who is neither temperamentally nor morally equipped to practice. Usually such a misfit drifts into other employment. Both the public and the profession benefits. But not all such leave the fold. They stay, and although their conduct may be such as to raise questions, from time to time, as to its propriety, nothing really can be done to disbar or even suspend or discipline them. They have violated the spirit, not the letter, of the canons. This is unfortunate. They are the bad apples in the barrel. The profession necessarily suffers in public esteem.

This brings up, not only the intellectual, but more especially, the moral fitness of candidates for admission to our law schools. Some schools require that they pass an aptitude test. Other tests may be used or later developed to sort out those not fit to enter law schools. If by such tests it should be shown an applicant would be an obvious misfit, or otherwise undesirable, then time and expense would be saved, not only by the school, but also by him.

The other day I read the Canons of Professional Ethics as printed in the front part of 164 Kansas. That Report was printed in 1948. These canons may have been revised slightly since then. We know some of them are being constantly reviewed in the light of experience. But, in the main, they are still the canons of the profession. I also read the latest rules of the Supreme Court relative to admission to the Bar. Their reading proved to be rather stimulating and rewarding. It made me deeply conscious of my own shortcomings. In our strenuous pursuit of things material, we sometimes are inclined to forget the things of the spirit. Legal ethics properly considered is a thing of the spirit. For example, ponder these words taken from the oath you all took:

"You do solemnly swear that . . . you will neither delay nor deny any man his right through malice, for lucre, or from any unworthy desire; that you will not knowingly foster or promote, or give your assent to, any fraudulent, groundless or unjust suit; that you will neither do, nor consent to the doing, of any falsehood in court; . . ."

Those words are literally freighted with meaning. They place upon each and every one of us a tremendous responsibility. They should not be taken lightly. And I am sure they are not by an overwhelming majority of lawyers.

Nevertheless, to those of you, however, who have had the fortitude to read this far, I commend the canons and the rules to your reading. Do it now. Don't put it off. It will not do any of you any harm. It might do some of you a "heap of good."

Summary of the Work of the Supreme Court

The following is a summary of the work of the Supreme Court for the year ended June 30, 1959, and the cases pending July 1, 1959.

There were 320 appealed civil cases disposed of within the year ended June 30, 1959. Of these 138 were dismissed without having been presented on the merits and 182 were submitted on the merits. Of these cases 114 were affirmed, 31 were reversed, 8 were affirmed in part and reversed in part, 3 were affirmed in part and modified in part, 8 were dismissed, 1 was reversed in part and remanded in part, 15 were reversed with direction, 1 was reversed in part and dismissed in part, and 1 was affirmed in part and dismissed in part.

The court disposed of 24 appealed criminal cases. Of this number 7 were dismissed without having been presented on the merits and 17 were submitted on the merits. Of these cases 14 were affirmed, 1 was reversed with direction, and 2 were dismissed.

The court also disposed of 41 original cases. Of this number 10 were dismissed without having been presented on the merits and 31 cases were submitted on the merits and written opinions filed, resulting in judgment for the plaintiff in 2 cases, judgment for the defendant in 27 cases, 1 case affirmed in part and dismissed in part, and 1 case accusation sustained.

This makes a total of 385 cases disposed of by the Supreme Court, of which 155 were dismissed without having been presented on the merits, and 230 decided on the merits.

The cases pending July 1, 1959, are as follows: 234 appealed civil cases; 23 appealed criminal cases; and 17 original cases, making a total of 274 cases pending.

Of the 230 cases submitted to the Supreme Court on the merits, in 6 cases the opinions were filed before the regular opinion day, in 175 cases on the first regular opinion day, in 22 cases on the second regular opinion day, in 5 cases on the third regular opinion day, and in 2 cases on the ninth regular opinion day. Twenty cases were denied on the day they were filed.

The regular opinion day is ordinarily a month after the case is submitted, more accurately it is the Saturday of the week hearings are had the next month after the case is submitted.

In 182 appealed civil cases in which opinions were filed within the year ending June 30, 1959, the time between the date notice of appeal was filed in this court and the date the case was submitted on its merits was as follows: within 3 months 1 case; in 3 to 4 months 3 cases; in 4 to 5 months 6 cases; in 5 to 6 months 17 cases; in 6 to 7 months 8 cases; in 7 to 8 months 22 cases; in 8 to 9 months 71 cases; in 9 to 12 months 44 cases; and over 12 months 10 cases.

In the 17 appealed criminal cases in which opinions were filed within the year ended June 30, 1959, the time between the date notice of appeal was filed in this court and the date the case was submitted on its merits was as follows: within 3 months no cases; in 3 to 4 months no cases; in 4 to 5 months no cases; in 5 to 6 months 3 cases; in 6 to 7 months no cases; in 7 to 8 months

2 cases; in 8 to 9 months 4 cases; in 9 to 12 months 6 cases; and over 12 months 2 cases.

There were pending in the Supreme Court July 1, 1959, a total of 274 cases as compared to 284 cases on the same date in 1958, 312 cases on the same date in 1957, 272 cases on the same date in 1956, 245 cases on the same date in 1955, 197 cases on the same date in 1954, 192 cases on the same date in 1953, 223 cases on the same date in 1952, 99 cases on the same date in 1951, 189 cases on the same date in 1950, 166 cases in 1949, 109 cases in 1943, 175 cases in 1942, 144 cases in 1941, 192 cases in 1940, 249 cases in 1939, 244 cases in 1938, 210 cases in 1937, 268 cases in 1936, 291 cases in 1935, 366 cases in 1934, 333 cases in 1933, 357 cases in 1932, 393 cases in 1931, 397 cases in 1930, 376 cases in 1929, and 341 cases in 1928.

In the 32 years the clerk of the Supreme Court has furnished us detailed information of the work of the court, it has disposed of 13,683 cases, of which 4,444 were dismissed before submission, and 9,239 were submitted on the merits and written opinions filed.
