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FOREWORD

This issue of the BULLETIN contains a list of court dates for 1971 in the various district courts of the state of Kansas.

A brief summary of activities and accomplishments of the Kansas Judicial Council for the past year will follow.

On July 1, 1970, the new Criminal Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure became effective as law in the state of Kansas. The enactment of this legislation marks the completion of a project begun by the Judicial Council and its Criminal Code Advisory Committee in 1963. The committee will continue in operation to make recommendations concerning amendments to the Criminal Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure. The committee met in May of this year to make recommendations to the Council for the adoption of new rules of appellant procedure in criminal cases by the Supreme Court. The present members of this committee are: Hon. Doyle E. White of Arkansas City, Chairman and member of the Council; Hon. Alex Hotchkiss, Lyndon; Prof. Paul E. Wilson, Lawrence; J. Richard Foth, Topeka; George T. Van Bebber, Troy, and Gene Olander, Topeka. Justice John F. Fonton, Supreme Court, and James R. James, Judicial Administrator, are Ex Officio members of the committee.

Pursuant to a request of the 1970 legislature a new Advisory Committee was appointed to study the ". . . feasibility and advisability of limiting, restricting or abolishing governmental immunity by statute . . ." The operations of this committee will not be completed before the 1971 session of the legislature and an interim report will be made at that time. A full report along with recommendations and any legislation necessary to implement these recommendations will be made to the 1972 session of the legislature. The members of this Advisory Committee are: Marvin Thompson of Russell, Chairman and member of the Council; Wright Crummett, Topeka; John Dekker, Wichita; Patrick F. Kelly, Wichita; David H. Heilman, Council Grove; Donald C. Smith, Dodge City, and Donald Hickman, Arkansas City.

A new Advisory Committee, appointed by the Judicial Council in 1969, is presently operating. A Judicial Council Bulletin dated July 1956, is the last publication of the Council carrying forms on probate practice. Changes in the Probate Code enacted by the legislature since that date have made some of the forms obsolete and require changes in others. This committee will continue in operation until these forms are completed. At the completion of this work Probate Forms will be published in a special Judicial Council Bulletin. Members of this committee are: Robert H. Cobean of Wellington, Chairman and member of the Council; Roy Kirby, Coffeyville; Malcolm G. Copeland, Topeka; Walter G. Stumbo, Topeka; Jon C. Christlieb, Kansas City, and Clifford Holland, Jr., Russell.

A new Advisory Committee was appointed by the Judicial Council in 1969 to draft Criminal Jury Instructions to be used with the new Criminal Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure. The work of this committee should

be completed and ready for publication sometime during 1971. The members of this committee are: Hon. Alex Hotchkiss of Lyndon, Chairman and member of the Council; Hon. David Prager, Vice Chairman, Topeka; Hon. B. Mack Bryant, Wichita; Hon. Albert B. Fletcher, Junction City; Hon. Don Musser, Pittsburg; Hon. Herbert W. Walton, Olathe; Hon. Frederick Wolesslagel, Lyons, and Prof. Earl B. Shurtz, Lawrence.

A new Advisory Committee was appointed in 1970, by the Judicial Council, to study the implications of *Chapin v. Aylward*, 204 Kan. 448, and to make recommendations for legislation, if necessary, to the Judicial Council. The members of this committee are: Jack E. Dalton of Dodge City, Chairman and member of the Council; Morris Moon, Augusta; Wilbur H. Jones, Wichita; Hylton Harman, Kansas City, and Robert F. Lytle, Prairie Village.

Since the enactment of the new Code of Civil Procedure, a Civil Code Advisory Committee has continued to study rules in connection with the new Code, making recommendations to the Council for the adoption of new rules by the Supreme Court. The present members of this committee are: Hon. Alex Hotchkiss of Lyndon, Chairman and member of the Council; Justice John F. Fontron, Supreme Court, Ex Officio, Topeka; Leonard O. Thomas, Kansas City; Hon. David Prager, Topeka; Emmett A. Blaes, Wichita; Marvin E. Thompson, Russell, and Morris D. Hildreth, Coffeyville.

In the past, practicing attorneys have been employed by the Judicial Council Advisory Committees to perform necessary research and to draft legislation. On February 16, 1970, Mr. John M. Jaworsky was employed as a full-time Research Assistant in the Judicial Council Office. On August 1, 1970, all research positions were consolidated into the Judicial Council Office and Mr. Jaworsky resumed the position of Reporter for all Judicial Council Committees. At that time Mrs. Nell Ann Gaunt was employed as a full-time legal secretary to assist with the increased workload.

The members of the Judicial Council and its Advisory Committees look forward to a period of increased activity which, it is hoped, will be of greater benefit to the Bar, the Judiciary, and to the public.

NOTE 1. See Rule No. 113 of the Supreme Court, relating to District Courts.

NOTE 2. See Rule No. 122 (d) (1) of the Supreme Court, amended October 29, 1970, to read as follows:

Allen County: 3rd Monday in January
 3rd Monday in May
 3rd Monday in October

NOTE 3. See Rule No. 122 (t) (4) of the Supreme Court, amended October 29, 1970, to read as follows:

Russell County: 4th Monday in January
 4th Wednesday in October
 10:00 a.m. for trials to the court and 9:00 a.m. for jury trials.

NOTE 4. In Bourbon, Linn and Miami Counties, court convenes at 10:00 a.m. Douglas County all court days open at 9:30 a.m. On days on which a term of court opens, the civil docket will be called beginning at 9:30 a.m. and the criminal docket will be called beginning at 2:00 p.m.

NOTE 5. In Douglas County, all pre-trial motions filed during any week, except motions in domestic relations cases, shall be heard by the Administrative Judge at 9:30 a.m. on Friday of the following week.

NOTE 6. In Labette County, Parsons Division, July 28 and August 25, are Civil Court days and July 29 and August 26, are Criminal Court days. Counties, all motion days are arraignment days for criminal actions.

NOTE 7. In Cloud, Jewell, Lincoln, Mitchell, Republic and Washington Counties, all motion days are pre-trial motions filed during any week, except motions in domestic relations cases, shall be heard by the Administrative Judge at 9:30 a.m. on Friday of the following week.

NOTE 8. In Sedgewick County, all post-trial motions and petitions filed under K.S.A. 60-1507 will be heard at 2:00 p.m. on the following days by the Judge of the Division which tried the case:

Division 1: First Thursday of each month;
 Division 2: First Friday of each month;

Division 3: Second Thursday of each month;
 Division 4: Second Friday of each month;

Division 5: Third Thursday of each month;
 Division 6: Third Friday of each month;

Division 7: Fourth Thursday of each month.

All motions in civil cases shall state the date, time and Division of Court in which the motion is to be heard.

All motions in domestic relations cases which have been on file five (5) days or more, (including contempt, change of custody, and modification of previous orders), shall be peremptorily heard by the Judge of the Division to which the case has been permanently assigned at 9:30 a.m. on the following days:

Division 1: First Thursday of each month;
 Division 2: First Friday of each month;
 Division 3: Second Thursday of each month;
 Division 4: Second Friday of each month;
 Division 5: Third Thursday of each month;
 Division 6: Third Friday of each month;

Division 7: Fourth Thursday of each month.
 All motions in domestic relations shall state the date, time and Division of Court in which the motion is to be heard.

In all felony cases where the defendant is bound over to the District Court, and all appeals from inferior courts shall be arranged on Wednesday of the second following week at 2:00 p.m. by the Administrative Judge.

NOTE 9. In Marshall County, opening day of the September term of court is delayed one day a/c Labor Day. In addition to the regular days of court in Division One in Riley County, time permitting, special days of court will be held on the 3rd Friday of the month. Also, special days of court in Division One and Two will be scheduled in Clay, Marshall and Riley Counties as the need arises.

NOTE 10. In Finney, Scott and Wichita Counties, central time is shown. In Greeley, Hamilton and Kearny Counties, mountain time is shown. Also, see Rule No. 122 (y) (3) of the Supreme Court, amended October 29, 1970, to read as follows:

Hamilton County: 4th Monday in February
 3rd Monday in October

NOTE 11. In Haskell, Grant, Stanton, Morton, Stevens and Seward Counties, Court will convene as follows—Central time:

First day of each Regular Term—10:00 a.m.
 Afternoon sessions—2:00 p.m.—10:00 a.m.

NOTE 12. In Wyandotte County, pre-trial and post-trial motions in divorce cases are heard every Friday in the division to which the case is assigned, except that any motion requiring presentation of oral evidence will be specially set by the judge. All other motions are heard in the division to which the case is assigned on the dates indicated above. All pre-trial motions in criminal cases are assigned for hearing by the Assignment Judge. No regular motion days are designated during the months of July and August; however, each judge will hear his motions at such times as will be fixed by him. All pre-trial motions in divorce cases and emergency matters will be heard each Friday by the judge on duty during July and August. All judges are present on Friday of each week to hear motions and matters not requiring a jury except during the months of July and August. All such matters are heard in the Division to which the case has been assigned. Any matter requiring the presentation of oral testimony must be specially set by the judge. All attorneys of record will be notified of settings by the Assignment Clerk.
