## **FOREWORD**

---

This Bulletin contains a list of court dates for 1974 in the various district courts of the state of Kansas.

---

A brief summary of activities and accomplishments of the Kansas Judicial Council for the past year will follow.

During the year 1973 the Kansas Judicial Council received three new members. The Hon. J. C. Tillotson of Norton, and the Hon. John F. Hayes of Hutchinson, assumed their position on the Council in January of 1973 by virtue of their chairmanship of the Judiciary Committees of the Senate and House, respectively. Senator Tillotson took the position on the Council previously held by the Hon. Steadman Ball of Atchison. Representative Hayes took the position previously held by the Hon. Jack R. Euler of Wathena.

The Judicial Council lost a distinguished and dedicated member in May of 1973 when the Hon. Alex Hotchkiss of Lyndon passed away. In June of 1973 the Hon. Albert B. Fletcher, Jr., Judge, Eighth Judicial District, was appointed to the Judicial Council to fill the vacancy.

The Judicial Council Ad Hoc Advisory Committee will continue to be available to the Council throughout the year 1974. The members of the committee advise the Council on ways and means to take advantage of funds provided under the provisions of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, which are administered through the Governor's Committee on Criminal Administration. The Governmental Immunity Advisory Committee was appointed in 1970, pursuant to a resolution of the legislature. A full report with recommendations was presented to the 1973 session of the legislature. The recommendations were held over for study by legislative committee and it is anticipated they will be acted upon during the 1974 legislative session. The members of this committee are: Marvin E. The Advisory Committee on Standards for Criminal Justice prepared a complete comparative analysis of the American Bar Association's Standards for Criminal Justice with Kansas Law, Rules and Legal Practice. The Judicial Study Advisory Committee is working under the Judicial Council and the Kansas Supreme Court to make a survey and study of the Kansas court system. Such survey and study is designed to include: (1) Unification and restructuring of the courts; (2) administrative supervision of the courts; (3) selection, tenure, compensation and retirement of judges and court personnel; (4) appellate review; (5) financing of courts; and (6) such other areas assigned to it by the chief justice. The chief justice shall report to the judiciary and the 1974 legislature on such part of the study that is completed during 1973. It will continue to function during the year 1974 if a determination by the Supreme Court and the Kansas Judicial Council deems it necessary. The members of this committee are: Edward F.
